She has collaborated with artists across the US, toured her original music throughout the West Coast, Canada and Europe, and produced benefit concerts for local and global causes. In addition to pursuing her own creative works, Arielle enjoys teaching high school music and digital art classes, going on weekend road trips throughout the state and working on house projects with her fiancé, Jace.



Quincy native Natalie Hagwood may be the changing face of the modern-day cellist. Unbridled by past conventions of what her instrument could and should do, the 28-year-old Sacramento transplant, who began formal cello training at age seven, continues to blossom, as do her fellow musical bandmates, heralded Sacramento trio Dear Darling. As her ascent with Dear Darling continues, her desire to explore new musical horizons and expand the

changing role of cello in contemporary music continues with solo releases that have helped her find her "true voice" and quench her self-professed "hunger for creativity."

As a child, Natalie grew up with the music of the church, sang harmonies with her singer/songwriter father, and was encouraged to further her musical education by her mother. She fell in love with youth symphony in her junior high years, and during her high school years took cello lessons from a University of Nevada Reno cello teacher who encouraged her to pursue a degree in Classical Cello Performance, a degree she would eventually receive from the University of Nevada in 2017.





Recognized for more than her considerable vocal skills, Hannah Jane Kile's proficiency as an acoustic and electric guitarist has been lauded by both peers and critics who have often called her "a player who sings, rather than a singer who plays." Follow that up with classical voice training and an enduring infatuation with the music of Steven Sondheim, and you have the genre-defying voice that is Hannah Jane Kile.



Selena Delgadillo is a pianist and singer based in the Sacramento area. Selena Delgadillo is a music major that started off her journey in the fall semester of 2020 at Cosumnes River College with a primary focus on piano and currently, she is now studying for a B.M. in Piano Performance at Sacramento State University! recitals and concerts, or performing at events with her jazz-fusion band, The Interlude.

Music has always been such a huge, fundamental base for her life and that has enabled her to spread the joy of playing and being involved with music. Los Angeles native Casey Lipka has traversed a wide variety of sonic worlds.

Lipka's travels over the years have established herself as a musical chameleon. In the years since earning her master's in Music Education from Bard College, she's toured as a bassist with rock band CAKE, composed music for

ballet and museum installations, and fronted an 18-piece orchestra celebrating the music of Motown legends Marvin Gaye and Tammi Terrell.

An amalgam of pop, folk, and jazz wrapped in a neo-classical vibe, her ethereal sound exudes both vulnerability and strength. Fast forward to current day where the thirty-something Lipka's musical universe continues to expand with collaborative folk trio Dear Darling, while developing an emerging body of solo work under her own name. She is working on her debut EP set to release in Spring 2023.

"It's about reaching people and bringing them together to create a meaningful experience", Lipka says, "in hopes of sparking a conversation of some sort". Casey Lipka's heartfelt compositions and mellifluous voice may cause and occasional skipped heartbeat, but as the singer/songwriter might say, that's all part of the long journey home.
